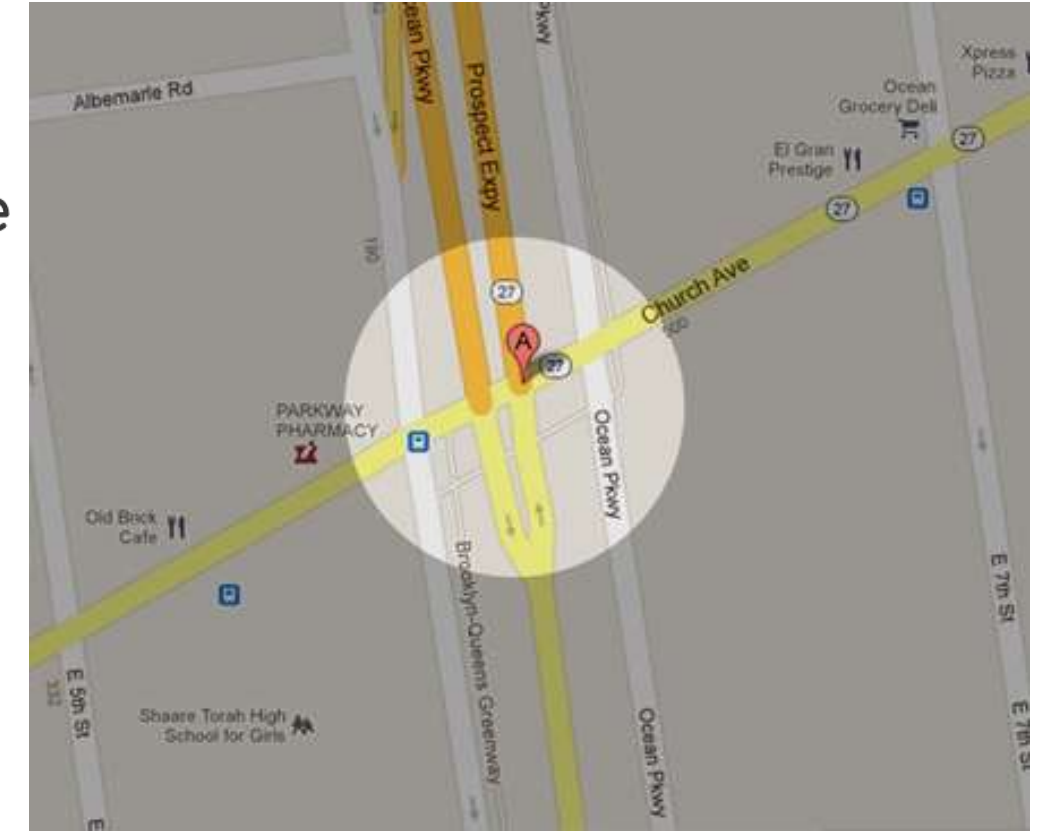


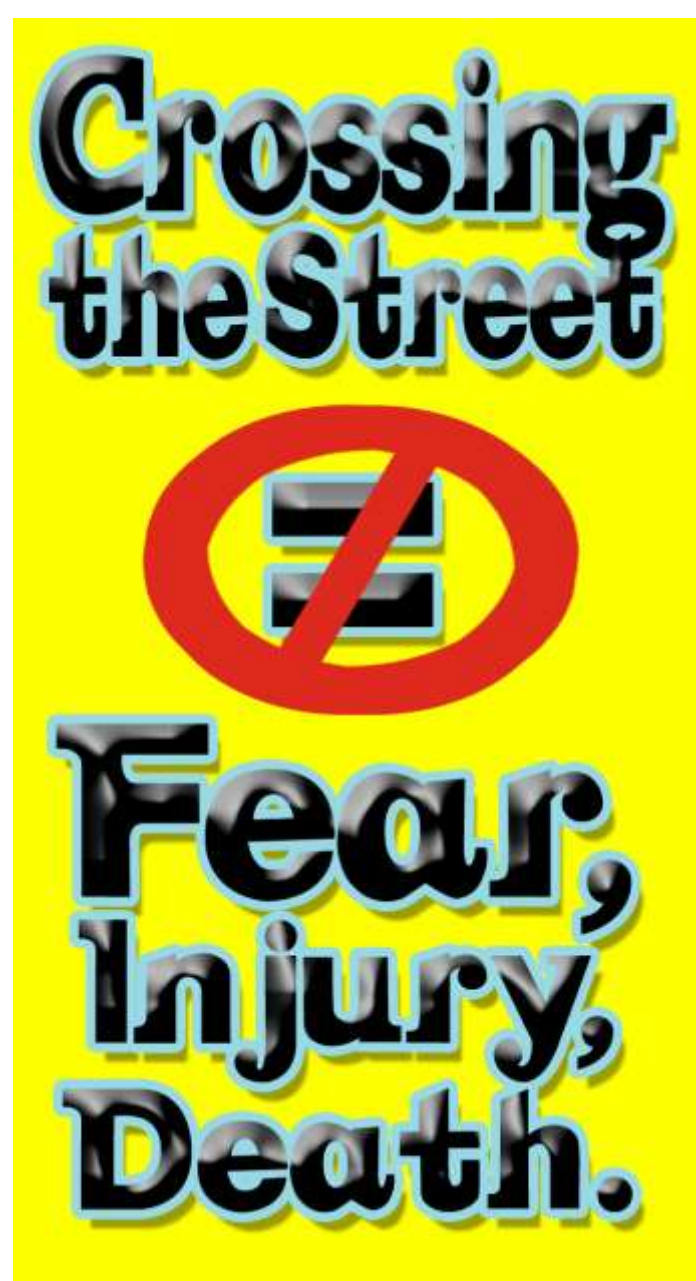

Addition of pedestrian safety island and repair of sidewalks and damaged crosswalk to keep people in less danger from traffic when crossing the 9 lanes of the Prospect Expressway



Cost \$200,000

Location Prospect Expressway/Ocean Parkway from Albemarle Road to Church Avenue

Who Benefits

Children, adults and seniors who must cross the Prospect Expressway daily in order to access schools, transportation, commercial & health services.

Project Description

Too short a crossing time, too long a crossing distance, dangerously damaged pavement and too many cars turning fast to run into pedestrians are the features of this vital pedestrian crosswalk. It is uniquely dangerous, and pedestrians and the neighborhood have been uniquely neglected by both city and state.

This proposal is an attempt to finally come to the aid of the hundreds of pedestrians that have to use this area daily. This is where their crossing the street is a gamble, a place in the neighborhood where they are second to motorists, and where rundown conditions have been ignored and left to get worse for years.
